The Forum, commemorating the 40th anniversary of the founding the Cardiology Research Institute of Tomsk National Research Medical Center of the Russian Academy of Sciences, will take place in the Harmony Exhibition Complex (Tomsk).

The Forum is planned as a multidisciplinary event aimed at exchange of advanced scientific knowledge and practical experience in the fields of epidemiology, prevention, diagnostics, conservative and surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of patients with of a wide range of cardiovascular diseases.

We invite Russian and foreign scientists, practicing physicians, young scientists, postgraduate students, and medical residents working in the current trends of cardiology, cardiac surgery, and allied clinical disciplines to become the speakers, presenters, and participants of the Forum.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select symposia for inclusion in the Scientific Program of the Forum. The chairmen of the symposia will be notified regarding an inclusion of the scientific event into the Program of the Forum before February 01, 2020.

Proposals for presentations

Applications for both oral and poster presentations may be submitted after filling the registration form in a personal account on website of the Forum at <http://forum.cardio-tomsk.ru> from **November 01, 2019 to January 20, 2020** simultaneously with a submission of the abstracts. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select presentations for inclusion in the Scientific Program of the Forum. The authors will be notified regarding an inclusion of their presentations into the Program of the Forum before February 15, 2020.

Abstracts

Abstracts may be submitted via a personal account on website of the Forum at <http://forum.cardio-tomsk.ru> **from November 01, 2019 to January 20, 2020** and will be published in the Forum Proceedings after the review. Abstracts, submitted by young

scientists and specialists younger than 39 years, will provide the basis for the Program of Young Scientists Scientific Session with oral presentations.

Young Scientist Contest

The young scientists and specialists younger than 39 years are invited to participate in the contest. The authors must fill out the registration form and submit the work for the Contest via a personal account on website of the Forum at <http://forum.cardio-tomsk.ru> from **November 1, 2019 to January 20, 2020**. While submitting the work, the authors may select a suitable section in the submission form.

The Young Scientist Contest will be held in three nominations:

- Contest of original research (in the English language)
- Contest of original research (in the Russian language)
- Contest of clinical case presentations (in the Russian language)

To participate in the Contest, the author (without co-authors!) may present only one work for each nomination without duplicating the works in the Russian and English languages.

The requirements for preparing the works for original research and clinical case contests are available on website of the Forum at <http://forum.cardio-tomsk.ru>. The works submitted for the Contest will be peer-reviewed. The results of an expert review will be posted on website of the Forum and sent to the authors by e-mail after March 1, 2020. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject an application for the Contest if the work does not comply with the theme and/or the level of the Forum.

The best six works in each nomination will be selected for delivering oral presentations at the final of the Contest. The finalists of the Contest will have an opportunity to prepare manuscripts for publication of the articles in the Siberian Medical Journal, which is recommended by the State Commission for Academic Degrees and Titles of the Russian Federation for publication of dissertation results. The authors of works, which have not reached to the final of the Contest, but received positive evaluation by the reviewers, will have an opportunity to give talks in the form of oral presentations and e-posters at the scientific sessions of the Young Scientist Seminar or other scientific sessions of the Forum "Cardiology of XXI Century: the Alliances and Potential".

Once again, we draw your attention to the deadline for submission of works to the Young Scientist Contest: submission of works will end on January 20, 2020
